

THE PATRIARCH ABRAHAM, ISAAC AND JACOB (I.E. ISRAEL)

The gospel was preached to Abraham, and the gospel became a generational endeavor; from generation to generation Hebrews 7:4, Galatians 3:8, Exodus 3:6 & 13-15

The word patriarch is usually applied to the progenitors of the gospel of Christ; Abraham, Isaac, Jacob (also known as Israel), the twelve sons of Jacob and David




RF: 1 Kings 18:36, Acts 7:8-9, 2:29-32

NOTE:

- The Gospel became a generational endeavor, which was preached to Abraham and also committed to the patriarchs Galatians 3:8, Acts 2:29-36
- Those fathers of Israel that refused to continue with the generational endeavor; the gospel that was preached to Abraham, were referred to; as the abominations of the fathers Ezekiel 20:1-9 & 18-19 (see vs. 4, 7-8), Acts 7:37-53 (see vs. 39-40, 51-53), John 8:31-59 (see vs. 33, 37, 39-40, 41, 43-44, 47, 51-53, 56, 58)

THE TWELVE PATRIARCHS

The twelve sons of Jacob; who were the twelve tribe of Israel. They were also patriarchs, progenitors of the gospel of Christ. One of them, who was Joseph spoke of the visitation, which was also the promise to Abraham.

RF: Acts 7:8-9, Genesis 50:24-25, Acts 7:17, Hebrews 11:8-10 (see vs. 9-10)

NOTE:

- The visitation or promise is also the concept of the gospel of Christ Genesis 50:24-25, Acts 7:17, Galatians 3:16, Acts 26:4-8 (see vs. 7)
- The promise belonged to Israel, from generation to generation (i.e. the generational endeavor; the gospel of Christ). And also the gentiles are partakers of His promise in Christ by the gospel Romans 9:3-4, Ephesians 3:6, Galatians 3:28-29
- There is the day of visitation (i.e. the gospel of Christ) and the day of recompense or punishment (i.e. the wrath of God to those that believe not the gospel) Luke 19:41-44, Hosea 9:7 (CEV, NLT), 1 Peter 4:17 (2 Thessalonians 1:8, Romans 2:4-11), 1 Peter 2:12, Job 10:12 (1 Thessalonians 5:23)

CHAPTER THREE

THE PATRIARCH DAVID

The patriarch David is also a progenitor of the gospel of Christ. The Lord God had sworn in truth to David that of the fruit of his body will sit on his throne

RF: Psalm 132:11, Acts 2:25-36 (see vs. 29-32, 34, 36), 13:32-38

NOTE:

- The key of David had been given to Christ Isaiah 22:20-22, Revelation 3:7
- Also, the sure mercies of David had been given to Christ Isaiah 55:3-4, Acts 13:34
- Christ would also sit on the throne of David forever Acts 2:29-30, Luke 1:31-33
- Christ would also rule the nations with the rod of Iron Psalm 2:1-12 (see vs. 6-9), Revelation 12:5, 19:11-21 (see vs. 15), Daniel 2:44, Revelation 11:15

- It is also the dispensation of the fulness of times Ephesians 1:9-10
